The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Saddam Sk., in connection with Memari P.S. Case No. 746 of 2025 dated 29.10.2025 U/S 305(a) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

T.C.R. received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 08.01.2026 and his further detention is no more required for interrogation. It is further that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition considering his period of detention, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises strong objection against the prayer for bail and submits that there are several cases pending against the petitioner and this petitioner is habitual offender.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is evident that the accused is in custody for a considerable period of time.

However, considering the materials available in the C.D., nature of allegation, stage of investigation, facts and circumstances and period of detention undergone by him, I am inclined to release him on bail. Hence, prayer of the petitioner for bail u/s 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

Above named accused person thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 6,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 3000/- each, one of whom must be cash surety in the form of NSC/ F.D. etc. subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further condition to meet with the I.O. of the case once in a fortnight till submission of report by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
