Order no. 02 dated 11.03.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail Under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sanikul Alam, who apprehends arrest in connection with Ausgram P.S. Case No. 34 of 2026 dated 27.01.2026 U/Ss 305(e)/317(2)/61(2) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

T.C.R. received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this accused being the registered owner of the vehicle allegedly involved in the alleged offence, did not commit any serious offence as alleged and she has been falsely implicated in this case, and nature of allegation is as such, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in this case. Moreover, driver of the vehicle who was arrested has been released on bail by the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Formal objection raised by the Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Considered the submissions placed. Perused the materials available on record and in the C.D. including the seizure list.

Considering the materials available in the C.D., nature of allegation, and facts and circumstances, I am of the view that custodial detention of the present petitioner is not needed in this case. Accordingly, his prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named petitioner in connection with the above noted case, she shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
