Order no. 02 dated 19.03.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail Under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Radha Kumari who apprehends arrest in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 212 of 2026 dated 26.02.2026 U/Ss 85/303(2)/351(2) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

T.C.R. received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this accused being the daughter in law of the complainant did not commit any serious offence as alleged and she has been falsely implicated in this case, and nature of allegation is as such, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required in this case. Moreover, this case is filed as a counter blast to the case filed by the petitioner against the complainant and others and this petitioner has also complied with the notice issued u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Objection raised by the Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Considering the materials available in the C.D., nature of allegation, and facts and circumstances depicted before the court, I am of the view that custodial detention of the present petitioner is not needed in this case. Accordingly, her prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named petitioner in connection with the above noted case, she shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) B.N.S.S. with further direction that he shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a month till submission of report by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
