Order no. 03 dated 30.03.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Sanjoy Jha, (2) Punam Roy, and (3) Jashoda Jha who apprehend arrest in connection with Shaktigarh P.S. Case No. 50 of 2026 dated 26.02.2026 U/Ss 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/305(a)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

T.C.R. received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that though an incident of hot altercation and scuffling took place between the parties, in which both side sustained minor injuries and filed cases against each other, these accused persons did not commit any serious offence and they have been falsely implicated in this case, and nature of allegation is as such, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Objection raised by the Ld. P.P. in-charge.

Considered the submissions placed. Perused the materials available on record and in the C.D. including the injury report.

Considering the materials available in the C.D., nature of allegation and injury, and facts and circumstances, I am of the view that custodial interrogation of the present petitioners is not needed in this case. Accordingly, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
