Order no. 02 dated 16.04.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail Under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Mohammad Suraj Hossain @ Md. Imran who apprehends arrest in connection with Shaktigarh P.S. Case No. 66 of 2026 dated 07.03.2026 U/Ss 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/74/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that there was affair between the parties. No such incident as alleged took place. Petitioner resides within the jurisdiction of this court and there is no chance of his abscondance. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. in-charge opposes the prayer for bail and submits that on completion of investigation charge sheet u/s 74 of B.N.S. has been submitted.

It appears from the record that the accused has been charge sheeted for the offences punishable U/Ss 329(4)/115(2)/74/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. While submitting the charge sheet I.O. of the case did not record any necessity of further investigation or interrogation of the accused. In view of the above, it seems that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary. Accordingly, prayer of the petitioner u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

Above named accused petitioner is directed to surrender before the concerned court within 10 working days hereof and in case he surrenders, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
