Fresh vakalatnama has been filed on behalf of the petitioner. Be
taken on record.

Memo of appearance filed on behalf of the insurance company.

There is delay in filing the DAR. IO to furnish the written
explanation duly forwarded by the SHO concerned in this regard by the next
date of hearing.

In view of Articles 21 & 22 of the Procedure for Investigation
of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (fifth
Amendment) Rules 2022, the DAR is treated as claim petition u/s 166,
Motor Vehicles Act 1988.

As the DAR has been treated as a claim petition u/s 166 (4) and section 140 of the MV Act therefore petitioner is directed to file a memo of parties on the NDOH reflecting himself as petitioner and with full details of the respondents of the present case.

Copy of the DAR has been supplied to Ld. counsel for the petitioner. Ld. counsel for the insurance company submits that she shall be filing her memo of appearance during the course of the day and shall also collect copy of the DAR today itself.

Since the insurance company has put in its appearance today, it is directed to examine DAR and file an appropriate response in the prescribed Form in terms of the Articles 26 & 31 of Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (fifth Amendment) Rules, 2022 in this Tribunal within 30 days with advance copy to the petitioner. R-3/ Insurance Company shall also furnish its complete bank details in the reply to the DAR. In case of default/delay in filing of the said response, appropriate costs shall be imposed upon the insurance company.

The IO submits that the respondent no. 2 owner is presently in Dubai and the respondent no. 1 driver was in touch with him for the past 3 days however today his phone is switched off.

Let notices be issued to respondents no. 1 and 2 through the IO for the next date of hearing. IO to be present along with the service reports.

Notice to the IO in this regard.

The petitioner may file statement of facts in the prescribed Form G. Delhi MACT Rules, 2008 within next 14 working days from today with advance copy to opposite party.

The petitioner is directed to open a bank account in nationalized bank near his place of residence and to place on record the photocopy of their passbooks, adhar card and pan card on the NDOH. The concerned bank is also directed not to issue any cheque book or debit card and to make an endorsement in this regard on the passbook of the petitioner itself. A copy of this order be given dasti to the petitioner to submit the same before the concerned bank.

The miscellaneous DJ no. 249/2026 i.e the application seeking the direction to the IO to file the DAR/ status report stands disposed off since the relief sought therein stands satisfied.

The application be tagged along with the present DAR.
