ORDER BELOW EXH.01

(Passed on this 04th August, 2026)

The applicant has filed this application for grant of regular bail under section 483 of B.N.S.S.

2. The informant lodged a report on 09.07.2026 alleging that, there was the birth day of her brother on 09.07.2026 therefore at 09.00 p.m, she herself, her husband, son and victim daughter had gone to the Cake shop situated in Bali Ves, Solapur. At that time, one servant at said shop who was sitting on a stool pushed her without any reason. She came out of the said shop and was waiting, at that time her victim

daughter told her that the said servant grabbed her breasts 2 to 3 times and outraged her modesty. Her son also witnessed the said incident. Accordingly, lodged the report.

3. As per applicant, he has not committed any offence. He has been falsely implicated in the crime. The investigation is completed. The learned Sp.P.P. contested the application by filing say at Exh.5. She submitted that the applicant committed serious offence and filing of charge sheet is not changed in circumstances. The victim also contested the application by filing say at Exh.6. She submitted that there is a possibility of commission of the same type of offence.

4. The applicant was arrested on 10.07.2026. The investigation is completed. Charge sheet is filed. The trial will take its own time. Therefore, it is necessary to release the applicant on bail. Hence, the order.

ORDER

01. The application is allowed.
02. Applicant **Rajshekhar Gurubasappa Patil** be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount in connection with Crime No. 570/2026 registered with Faujdar Chawadi Police Station, Solapur, on the following conditions.
 - (i) He shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner and shall not indulge in any type of criminal activity/similar offence.

- (ii) He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts before.
- (iii) He shall attend concerned police station as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (iv) Violation of any above condition may entail a ground for cancellation of bail forthwith.
