Pintu Kumar Shaw @ Bhoma - versus- The State

The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Pintu Kumar Shaw @ Bhoma in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 515 of 2026 dated 13.05.2026 U/Ss 310(4)/310(5) of B.N.S. and 25/27 of Arms Act is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner is in custody for more than a month. He has been falsely implicated. Process of search and seizure has been completed. There is no further recovery. Further detention will serve no purpose. Some other accused persons have been granted bail by this court. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are sufficient incriminating materials in the C.D. against the present petitioner.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is evident that the F.I.R. was lodged by one S.I. of police alleging therein that the petitioner with his associates assembled for committing dacoity and they were making preparation for the same.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has recorded the statements of the witnesses. The I.O. has also seized the fire arms and ammunition from the possession of the this accused. However, considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, no development in the investigation and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan, with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
