The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Choudhury Md. Ashad in connection with Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 252 of 2025 dated 12.09.2025 U/S 61(2)/319(2)/318(4)/338/340(1)(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been a witness to the disputed deed. On completion of investigation charge sheet has been submitted. Case is triable by the court of Magistrate. It is further submitted that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge opposes the prayer for bail and submits that this petitioner played prominent role in the transaction with respect of the Wakf property.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the accused persons named in the petition of complaint represented themselves as owners of the property in dispute and transferred the same with a view to deprive the complainant.

On perusal of the materials in the C.D. it appears that on completion of investigation, I.O. of the case has submitted charge sheet. Disputed deed has been seized during investigation. Ld. P.P. In-charge admits that present petitioner is a witness to the said deed. Considering the facts and circumstances and also considering the fact that investigation has been completed and role of the present petitioner in the disputed transaction, his prayer U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner namely Choudhury Md. Ashad thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
