Nitul Sarkar - versus- The State

Order no. 02 dated 04.06.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail Under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Nitul Sarkar who apprehends arrest in connection with Kalna P.S. Case No. 272 of 2026 dated 24.04.2026 U/Ss 329(4)/74/64/62/118(1)/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that present petitioner is innocent and out of previous grudge, F.I.R. was lodged with intention of humiliating him and for lowering his prestige in the society. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. in-charge does not raise any objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged in the written complaint that the complainant is engaged in the business of making incense stick. Present petitioner is her worker. Her husband stays outside. In absence of her husband petitioner outraged her modesty and attempted to commit rape upon her. He also posted her obscene photographs with vulgar comments touching her character in social media platform.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. of the case has examined several witnesses and recorded their statements. The I.O. has also collected the copies of some objectionable posts. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offence alleged and supporting materials in the C.D., prayer of the petitioner u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is rejected.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
