Order No. 15 Dated 04.02.2026

This day is fixed for hearing of a petition dated 06/11/2025 filed by the petitioner/husband namely Subhamoy Sen under Order 6 rule 17 of CPC praying for certain amendment on the ground stated therein.

Petitioner files hazira through his Ld. Advocate.

Perused the instant petition along with the materials on record.

Heard Ld. Advocate appearing on behalf of petitioner.

At the very outset I like to mention that the instant case has been fixed as ex parte hearing vide order No.12 dated 21.03.2025 against the opposite party-wife namely Fulmala Biswas @ Piyali Biswas .

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner- husband submitted that due to some typographical mistakes the date of marriage has been mentioned inadvertently as 02.02.2018 instead of 02.12.2018 in respect of para No. 1 of the instant petition filed u/s 13 (I) (ia) (ib) of Hindu marriage act for dissolution of marriage between the parties Ld. Advocate further submitted that he intend to incorporate another fact to the effect that one criminal case had been lodged by the O.P-wife with Krishnanagar Women P.S being no.60 of 2024 and the same is pending before the Ld. Court of CJM, Krishnanagar as the same has not mentioned in the original petition.

He further submitted that the amendment sought for is formal in nature and if the proposed amendment will be allowed the O.P-wife will not be prejudiced and the proposed amendment is necessary for arriving to just conclusion of this case and accordingly, prayed for allowing the proposed amendment.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and hearing the submission of the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner-husband it can safely be said that if the proposed amendment is allowed, the O.P-wife will not be prejudiced. Moreover, I also find that the amendment sought for is essential for proper adjudication of this case.

Hence, I find no bar to allow the instant petition. Accordingly the petition dt. 06/11/2025 is hereby allowed.

Thus, amend the original petition/plaint filed by the petitioner-husband and register the same accordingly. Let the amendment petition be made part of the original petition/plaint.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner is also directed to file the amended original petition/plaint by **01/04/2026** .

Amend the original petition accordingly.

B.C.-II is directed to do the needful at once.
