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Order no. 03 dated 16.06.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Sk. Rejabul @ Rijaul Mondal, (2) Rabiul Mondal, (3) Nurnehar Begam @ Hurnihar Mondal, and (4) Gajai Mondal @ Monjila Mondal who apprehend arrest in connection with Bhatar P.S. Case No. 263 of 2026 dated 17.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/115(2)/74/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that these petitioners have been falsely implicated over property dispute. In the meantime investigation has been completed. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge does not raise objection and points out that the victim refused to make statement before the Ld. Magistrate.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that on completion of investigation, the I.O. has submitted charge sheet for the offence u/ss 126(2)/115(2)/74/ 351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case nature of allegation and fact that charge sheet has been submitted, custodial interrogation of the petitioners does not appear to be necessary. Accordingly, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.\_

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
