Bapi Mondal & 2 others - versus- The State

The application for anticipatory bail U/S 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely Bapi Mondal, (2) Mithun Mondal, and (3) Manju Rani Mondal who apprehend arrest in connection with Raina P.S. Case No. 187 of 2026 dated 18.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/115(2)/118(2)/109(1)/303(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

At the very outset Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that he is not pressing this application in respect of the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 since they have been arrested. With the permission of the court, he put an endorsement to that effect on the application.

In view of the above, prayer for anticipatory bail made on behalf of the accused petitioner nos. (1) Bapi Mondal, and (2) Mithun Mondal stands rejected being not pressed.

Now, as regards the petitioner no. 3 heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioners that this petitioner is a female folk and she has been falsely implicated. No such allegation as made in the F.I.R. took place at all. The petitioner is a local resident having no chance of her abscondance. It is further submitted that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge does not oppose the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that while returning home, accused persons intercepted the complainant and assaulted him physically with brick bats and stone and snatched away a sum of Rs. 7000/-.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has collected the copy of the O.P.D. Ticket. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, nature of allegation and injury, prayer of the petitioner U/S 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner no.3 Manju Rani Mondal in connection with the above noted case, she shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on the conditions laid down u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S._

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
