

Sangeeta Rani and others Versus Jashanpreet Singh and others

Ld. counsel for claimants has made statement that he had no objection if the application filed by applicant Roshni Devi for impleading her as claimant no.4, was allowed. On the other hand, Ld. counsel for respondents no.1 and 2 stated at bar that they had also no objection, if this application was allowed.

2. This order of mine shall dispose of an application filed by applicant Roshni Devi for impleading her as claimant no.4 in the present claim petition. It was averred that claimants Sangeeta Rani and others had filed the present claim petition against the respondents for grant of compensation on account of death of Shanti Kumar, son of applicant, who died in a road side accident. Now, the applicant came to know that claimants had not impleaded her as party in the present claim petition. She was the necessary party and no prejudice was going to be caused to the other party. It was prayed that application be allowed.

3. Upon notice, respondent no.3 contested this application by filing reply, in which, they denied the averments of the application and prayed for its dismissal.

On the other hand, Ld. counsel for claimants and respondents no.1 and 2 raised their no objection in allowing this application.

4. I have heard Ld. counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

5. Applicant Roshni Devi is mother of deceased Shanti Kumar and this fact has not been denied by any of the parties. She, being mother of deceased Shanti Kumar, is the necessary party to be impleaded in this claim petition. Therefore, this application is hereby allowed and applicant Roshni Devi is ordered to be impleaded as claimant no.4 in the present claim petition.

Now, case is adjourned to 29.03.2025 for filing amended title by the claimants.

Neither any documents have been produced, nor reply to application for production of documents by respondents no.1 and 2, has been filed. Accordingly, respondents no.1 and 2 are directed either to file reply or to produce the documents in question on the date fixed.
