The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sk. Habibur Rahaman @ Chand in connection with Khandagosh P.S. Case No. 137 of 2026 dated 14.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/117(2)/109(1)/308(2)/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. & 25/27 of Arms Act is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner he has been falsely implicated in this case out of political grudge and he is in custody for 22 days. Though he was taken into P.C., there is no recovery of either any money allegedly extorted or any arms and ammunition. It is further submitted that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection and conceded that there is no recovery during the P.C. period.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the petitioner and co- accused extorted money from the complainant by putting the complainant under fear. On 10.04.2026 they also assaulted the complainant and extorted money from him as well as from the co-villagers

On perusal of the materials in the C.D. it appears that no fire arm or cash has been recovered during the P.C. period. Injury report collected by the I.O. during investigation shows that doctor noted abrasion in left leg lateral aspect. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner namely Sk. Habibur Rahaman @ Chand thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further condition that he shall meet with the I.O. of the case twice in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
