The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Ali Hossain Mondal @ Natu in connection with Khandaghosh P.S. Case No. 137 of 2026 dated 14.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/117(2)/109(1)/308(2)/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. and 25/27 of Arms Act is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner is in custody for more than a month. He has been falsely implicated. There is inordinate delay in lodging the F.I.R. without explanation. Principal accused has been released on bail by this court. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge does not oppose the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that during the post poll period of 2021, the petitioner with his associates extorted a sum of Rs. 15,000/- from the complainant on the gun point.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has recorded the statements of the witnesses. The I.O. has also seized the improvised arm and ammunition from the possession of the accused. However, considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, no development in the investigation and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan, with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
