The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely Subodh Ghosh @ Subodh Kumar Ghosh, and (2) Amar Kundu in connection with Galsi P.S. Case No. 354 of 2026 dated 17.05.2026 U/Ss 331(3)/118(2)/109(1)/308(5)/324(4)(5)/325/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. and 5(1) of the Indian Fisheries Act is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioners that these petitioners have been in custody for about a month. They have been falsely implicated. The F.I.R. is grossly delayed without any plausible explanation for the same. Though the petitioners were taken in P.C., no fruitful result yielded. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge does not oppose the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that during the post poll period of 2021, the petitioners with his associates trespassed into the house of the complainant by breaking open the entrance door and damaged the house hold articles and extorted a sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- from the F.I.R-maker by putting his under fear of death.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has recorded the statements of the witnesses. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, nature of allegation and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioners U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioners named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further direction that the petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till conclusion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
