The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely Bapi Mondal, and (2) Mithun Mondal in connection with Raina P.S. Case No. 187 of 2026 dated 18.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/115(2)/118(2)/109(1)/303(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioners that this petitioners they have been in custody for a considerable period of time. They have been falsely implicated. No such allegation as made in the F.I.R. took place at all. They are local residents having no chance of their abscondance. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge does not opposes the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that while returning home, accused persons intercepted him and assaulted him physically with brick bats and stone and snatched away a sum of Rs. 7000/-.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has collected the copy of the O.P.D. Ticket. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, nature of allegation and injury and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioners U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioners named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
