The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Biplab Mayis @ Mahish in connection with Shaktigarh P.S. Case No. 179 of 2026 dated 28.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/117(2)/109(1)/351(3)/324(4)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that there was fighting between the complainant and co- accused persons. This petitioner rushed to separate them. The complainant fell down on the ground and sustained injuries. This petitioner is in custody for 26 days. His further detention is no more required. It is further submitted that the complainant was discharged from the hospital on the next day. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection and submits that the medical document shows serious head injuries.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the petitioner with his associates being armed with bamboo physically assaulted the complainant causing serious injuries.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has collected the medical document. Considering the materials available, nature and seriousness of the offence alleged and supporting materials in the C.D., prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is rejected.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
