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Order no. 02 dated 04.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Sekh Kallam, (2) Anarul Haque Sahana @ Antu Sahana, (3) Jahur Alam Sahana @ Mintu Sahana, (4) Sallam Sk., (5) Manirul Haque Sahana @ Fatik Sahana, (6) Nijam Sk. @ Jahar Lal Sk., (7) Sekh Mofijul, (8) Sekh Omar Ali @ Kota, (9) Sekh Ujjal, (10) Sekh Hafijul @ Titon, and (11) Sekh Saukat Ali @ Mamu who apprehend arrest in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 150 of 2026 dated 19.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/117(2)/304/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that without any particulars of the offence F.I.R. has been lodged. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises mild objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that while the complainant was returning home in the evening the petitioners restrained him, physically assaulted him and snatched away money.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has examined the witnesses and recorded their statement. Amount of money allegedly stolen is not mentioned. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of allegation, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
