Uday Paul @ Pal & 3 Ors. - versus- The State

Order no. 03 dated 03.07.2026:

The application for bail under Section 482 of B.N.S.S.(formerly 438 of Cr. P.C.), filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely 1. Uday Paul @ Pal, 2. Chhaya Pal @ Paul, 3. Santana Pal @ Mondal, and 4. Hriday Pal, apprehending their arrest in connection with Ketugram P.S. Case No.329 of 2026 dated 03.06.2026 under Sections 85/316(2)/109/82(2)/3(5) BNS, is taken up for hearing.

Record of concerned G.R. Case has been received. C.D. is produced.

Heard the Learned Advocate for the petitioners and Learned P.P-in-Charge.

Perused the materials on record and C.D.

The Learned Advocate for the petitioners submits that they are the in-laws of the F.I.R.-maker. They have been falsely implicated. The Learned Advocate for the petitioners further submits that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, he prays that the petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail on any condition as this Court deems fit.

The Learned P.P. raises no objection.

It is alleged that since after giving birth of the male child, the husband and in-laws tortured the complainant physically and mentally on demand of further dowry. The petitioners are the in-laws. It appears that the I.O. of the case has collected medical documents and recorded statements of the witnesses. The alleged incident of attempt to kill the F.I.R.-maker by electrocution was made on 10.01.2026. The F.I.R. has been lodged long thereafter on 03.06.2026.

Considering the facts and circumstances and materials in C.D., the prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above-mentioned accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the usual conditions as stipulated in Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.

Record of G.R. Case be sent back together with a copy of this order to the concerned Court for information.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
