The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Birsha Singh @ Sing in connection with Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 135 of 2026 dated 09.04.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/118(2)/109(1) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner voluntarily surrendered before the court on 07.05.2026 and since then he is in custody. There is no chance of his abscondance if he is released on bail. It is further submitted that this petitioner also sustained injury in the said incident. It is further submitted that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection and submits that there are sufficient incriminating materials in the C.D. against this petitioner for the offences alleged and the injured has lost his eye.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is evident that trouble started between the parties during the Kalipuja in over the issue of playing loudspeaker. It is alleged that the petitioner struck left eye of complainant's grandson with a glass bottle.

It appears that the I.O. has collected the medical document. The injured has been discharged from the hospital. Petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of time. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
