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Order no. 02 dated 09.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely, (1) Sk Nuruddin @ Nuruddin Sheikh and (2) Sk Samsur @ Sheikh Samsul who apprehend arrest in connection with Khandaghosh P.S. Case No. 154 of 2026 dated 23.05.2026 U/Ss 85 of BNS is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that due to pretty domestic dispute the wife lodged FIR. Subsequently, the matter has been settled and the couple reside peacefully now. The Ld. Advocate further submits that the complainant is present with her Ld. Advocate. The Ld. Advocate further submits that the petitioner complied the notice u/s 35 of the BNSS. It is further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises mild objection.

Ld. Advocate for the complainant concedes to the submission made to the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and submits that the complainant has sworn affidavit declaring her no objection to granting bail to the petitioner. The case was started for the alleged offence u/s 85 of the BNS. In view of the subsequent development and for the sake of family peace, the prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of BNSS.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.
