The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sujay Mondal in connection with Memari P.S. Case No. 275 of 2026 dated 11.04.2026 U/Ss 85/80/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner is the husband. He is in custody for 89 days. Since charge sheet has been submitted, his further detention will serve no fruitful purpose. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are sufficient incriminating materials against this petitioner in the C.D. for the offence alleged.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that since after marriage, the husband subjected the complainant's daughter physically and mentally and her in laws also tortured her physically and mentally on demand of dowry. Since after giving birth to a female child, torture on her escalated. Subsequently, she died by hanging herself.

On perusal of materials in the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has seized one piece of paper written by the deceased implicating her in laws. Autopsy Surgeon opined that death was due to the effect of antemortem hanging. Doctor also noted non continuous oblique ligature mark around the neck. The I.O. has also collected the copies of the statements of the relatives of the deceased made before the Ld. Magistrate. Allegations are mainly leveled against the in laws. Considering the materials available, nature of allegation against this petitioner, facts and circumstances stated above, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
