The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely Sk. Ahamed Reza @ Sekh Ahammad Reja, and (2) Najrul Sk. in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 740 of 2026 dated 05.06.2026 U/Ss 3/4/5/6/7/9 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioners that these petitioners are the workers of the hotel having no control over the activities in the hotel. They are in custody since 06.06.2026. Co- accused persons have been granted bail by this court. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge opposes the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that on getting source information police party raided the hotel and arrested some boarders and present petitioners. Police party also seized some liquor, drinking glasses, contraceptives and cash sum of Rs. 5915/-. It is alleged that said hotel was being used as a place of prostitution for commercial purpose.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. of the case has recorded the statements of the witnesses and seized the articles stated above. Some other accused persons have been granted bail by this court. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioners U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioners named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further direction that the petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till conclusion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
