Order no. 02 dated 09.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely, (1) Sk Ajijul, (2) Sk Sadre Alam, (3) Sk Moni, (4) Sk Ahamat, (5) Jamal Mallick, (6) Soumen Tah and (7) Jayanta Khan who apprehend arrest in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 719 of 2026 dated 02.06.2026 U/Ss 448/341/323/325/384/427/506/34 of IPC is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that if the FIR is considered to be true on its face value no offence is made out. During 2021 several cases for commission of heinous offences were started against the FIR maker. After change of political regime the instant FIR was lodged as a backlash. It is further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection and points out that except statement u/s 161 CrPC there are no other materials in the CD.

The FIR maker has alleged that after the publication of Assembly Poll Result of 2021 the petitioners being the supporters of a particular political party trespassed into his house and damaged his elder brother's motor cycle. His parents, elder brother and brother-in-law were tortured mentally and physically. Thereafter some Hooligans set their straw wall on fire. His father was arrested in connection with an old case. His father and elder brother could not enter their house for six months. They demanded a sum of Rs. 12,00,000/- for settlement.

It appears from the documents shown by the petitioners that Burdwan PS Case No. 201/21 dt. 24-03-21 u/s 326/307/120B/34 of the IPC and Burdwan PS Case No. 202/21 dt. 24-03-21 u/s 447/427/323/354/34 of the IPC and u/s 3 of the SC/ST(POA) Act were registered against the complainant's father.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has recorded the statement of the witnesses. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and materials in the C.D., their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction that the petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
