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Order no. 02 dated 09.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely, (1) Nilkamal Das, (2) Ujjwal Das, (3) Biswajit Das, (4) Bhajahari Das, (5) Mrinmoy Das, (6) Sanatan Das, (7) Satkari Das, (8) Rohit Das, (9) Madhab Das, (10) Tirtha Das, (11) Subhajit Das, (12) Ujjwal Das, (13) Sukanta Das, (14) Sumanta Das and (15) Suman Das @ Somnath Ruidas who apprehend arrest in connection with Ausgram P.S. Case No. 187 of 2026 dated 11.05.2026 U/Ss 109(1)/118(1)/118(2)/115(2)/74/79/333/351(3)/352/296/3(5) of BNS is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that the granddaughter of the complainant fell in love with the petitioner no.2 which culminated into marriage. The complainant's family could not accept the marriage. They abducted the wife of the petitioner no.3 and physically assaulted the accused party and a case was started being Ausgram PS Case No. 36/26 dt. 28-01-26 u/s 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/118(2)/140(3)74/76/351(2)(3)/3(5) of BNS. As a counterblast the present FIR was lodged with false allegation. It is further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection and admits that there are no ingredients to support the allegations for the offence u/s 109 of the BNS. It is alleged that on 10-03-26 at about 4-00/5-00 in the afternoon the petitioner went out to answer the nature's call. The petitioner no.1 and 2 out of previous grudge assailed him physically and also assaulted his wife. The petitioner no.3 fetched a kitchen knife and gave a blow to the complainant.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has collected medical documents. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and materials in the C.D., their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of BNSS with further direction that the male petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
