Today is fixed for production of accused, and further evidence.

Sole accused person of the case namely Biswajit Patra is produced from J/C and he is placed on the dock.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person and Ld. P.P. in-charge are present.

Witnesses namely Shanku Patra and Bapan Chandra Khan are present.

The case is now taken up for evidence.

Witness Shanku Patra appears on dock and examined herself in chief as P.W.8.

In course of his examination in chief on the prayer of the prosecution, this witness is declared hostile and permission is granted to the prosecution to cross-examine the witness.

The witness is cross-examined by the prosecution. He is also cross-examined by the defence in full and discharged.

Now, other witness namely Bapan Chandra Khan appears on dock and examined himself in chief as P.W.9. He proves his statement recorded by the Magistrate u/s 164 Cr. P.C. as Ext.9 (formal proof dispensed with by the defence) and his signatures upon the said statement as Exts. 9/1 to 9/3 respectively.

During the course of his examination, Ld. P.P. In-charge by filing a petition prays for declaring the witness as hostile and also prays for cross-examination of this witness.

This prayer is allowed. This witness is declared hostile. Ld. P.P. In-charge is permitted to cross-examine the witness.

Said witness is cross-examined by the prosecution. He is cross-examined by the Ld. defence counsel in full and discharged.

No other witness is present today.

It is evident that tomorrow is also fixed for evidence. Hence, day is adjourned.

To 04.12.2024 for production of the accused, and further evidence.

Accused person be remanded to J/C with direction to produce them before the court on the next dates fixed.
