The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Shyamal Kr. Roy in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 703 of 2026 dated 30.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/109(1)/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

By showing some documents it is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that at the time of alleged incident he was in Nainital and not at the P.O. This petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case out of grudge. He is in custody for 33 days. Further detention will serve no fruitful purpose. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection and points out that the inured had no necessity for admission in any hospital..

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the petitioner struck complainant's father with an iron bucket causing serious injury.

It appears that the I.O. has collected the medical document. Petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of time. Considering the materials available, nature of allegation and injury, facts and circumstances, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
