The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely Dipak Balmiki, (2) Khokan Balmiki, and (3) Manoj Balmiki @ Monaj in connection with Khandaghosh P.S. Case No. 170 of 2026 dated 08.06.2026 U/Ss 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/109(1)/74/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioners that all the family members have been falsely implicated in this case. I.O. of the case made no prayer for P.C. There is no search and seizure. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raised objection and submits that the I.O. has collected the injury report which supports the case.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the accused persons being armed with dangerous weapons physically assaulted the complainant and his family members who have to be treated in the hospital.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has collected several medical documents showing several persons sustaining injuries. One sustained multiple injuries in the abdomen and another sustained head injury. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offence alleged, facts and circumstances, and supporting materials in the C.D., prayer of the petitioners U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is rejected.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
