The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely Ismail Sk., (2) Sk. Ahamed Reza, (3) Najrul Sk., and (4) Abdul Kerim in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 740 of 2026 dated 05.06.2026 U/Ss 3/4/5/6/9 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioners that if two adults engage in intimate physical relation, it is not an offence. Ld. Advocate further submits that it is not specifically stated the room numbers from which the petitioners and others were arrested. Actual place of seizure is not mentioned in the seizure list. These petitioners are in custody for a considerable period of time. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are sufficient incriminating materials in the C.D. against the present petitioners.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that immoral activities like prostitution for commercial purpose was carried on in the hotel and the petitioners and others were arrested from the place and incriminating materials were recovered from the P.O.

On perusal of the materials available, it appears that the I.O. has examined witnesses and recorded their statements. Petitioners are said to be customers. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioners U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioners named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further direction that the petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
