The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Shyamal Mehuli, in connection with Memari P.S. Case No. 125 of 2026 dated 15.02.2026 U/S 64(2)(f) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

T.C.R. received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 16.02.2026 and his further detention is no more required for interrogation. It is also submitted that matter has been settled amicably and to that effect, the de facto complainant has also filed an affidavit before this court. It is further stated that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition considering his period of detention, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises strong objection against the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D. including the statement of the victim recorded confidentially.

Considering the materials available in the C.D., nature of allegation, facts and circumstances and period of detention undergone by him, I am inclined to release him on bail. Hence, prayer of the petitioner for bail u/s 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

Above named accused person thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further condition that he shall meet with the I.O. of the case twice in a month for the next six months.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
