The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sk. Sabir @ Seikh Sabir Ali in connection with Khandaghosh P.S. Case No. 136 of 2026 dated 13.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/308(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been falsely implicated out of political rivalry. He is in custody since 15.06.2026. Co-accused persons are already on bail. Though he was taken in P.C. no fruitful result yielded. There is case and counter case. F.I.R. does not show any material for the offence u/s 109(1) of B.N.S. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises mild objection and leaves the matter to the discretion of the court.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that during the post poll period of 2021 the petitioner with his associates tortured the villagers and extorted money from them and on 26.04.2026 while the complainant was returning from bank withdrawing money, petitioners snatched away a sum of Rs. 2 lacs and threatened him with dire consequence.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the petitioner is in custody since 15.06.2026. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offence, stage of investigation and supporting materials in the C.D., prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is rejected.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
