The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Abdul Haque Mallick @ Chanchal in connection with Ausgram P.S. Case No. 197 of 2026 dated 16.05.2026 U/S 25(1B)(a) of Arms Act is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that the rider and pillion rider of the motor cycle were arrested on the allegation of possessing improvised fire arms without any lawful documents. This petitioner sold out the said motor cycle, though name was not changed. He has been falsely implicated. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection and submits that fire arms has been recovered from the Diki of the motor cycle.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that improvised fire arm was recovered from the possession of the accused persons named in the F.I.R.

On perusal of the materials available it appears that the I.O. has examined witnesses and recorded their statements. Nothing is recovered from the possession of this petitioner. He is the owner of the motor cycle. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan, with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
