Advocate for the petitioner prays for shifting back the date of hearing from 07.07.2026 to today and to allow him to conduct hearing this day, on the ground that another criminal misc.- case arising out of self same incident or police case is fixed up today and record and G.R. case and C.D. of the concerned case are also available with the court.

Later: Order No. 03 dated 04.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Hemu Ghosh @ Hemanta Kumar Ghosh, who apprehend arrest in connection with Galsi P.S. Case No. 471 of 2026 dated 15.06.2026 U/Ss 305(c)/61(2) of B.N.S. and 21(1)(4) of M.M.D.R. Act is now taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been falsely implicated. There is no allegation of excavation of minerals. He has complied with the notice issued u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S. There is no necessity of his custodial interrogation. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that during enquiry by the team consisting of the revenue officer and police personnel 4 J.C.Bs were seized.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has collected the seizure list and recorded the statements of the witnesses. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the petitioner has complied with the notice issued u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S., his prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

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In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner in connection with the above noted case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
