The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sk. Razzaque @ Raja, in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 1257 of 2025 dated 13.12.2025 U/S 305(a) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

T.C.R. received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner being not named in the F.I.R. has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 27.02.2026 and his further detention is no more required for interrogation. It is also submitted that this accused was taken on P.C. twice but nothing has been recovered from him. It is further stated that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition considering his period of detention, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises strong objection against the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is evident that the accused is in custody for a considerable period of time and nothing has been recovered from him though he was taken on remand twice.

Considering the materials available in the C.D., nature of allegation, facts and circumstances and period of detention undergone by him, I am inclined to release him on bail. Hence, prayer of the petitioner for bail u/s 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

Above named accused person thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 4,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further condition that he shall meet with the I.O. of the case twice in a month for the next six months.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
