The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Prasanta Goswami in connection with Ausgram P.S. Case No. 235 of 2026 dated 02.06.2026 U/Ss 448/325/384/427/506/34 of I.P.C. taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Learned Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been in 04.06.2026. This petitioner has been falsely implicated out of grudge. Offences alleged are triable by the court of Magistrate with sentence up to 3 years or fine or both. Though the petitioner was taken on remand, no fruitful result yielded. It is further submitted that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that during the post poll violence of 2021, the petitioner with his associates vandalized the house of the complainant and extorted a sum of Rs. 2,50,000/- from him.

It appears that the petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2026. No fruitful result yielded during P.C.

Considering the materials available, nature of allegation, facts and circumstances, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
