By filing another application, Ld. Advocate for the petitioner prays for shifting back the date of hearing from 13.07.2026 to today and to allow him to conduct hearing this day, on the ground that another criminal misc.- case arising out of self same incident or police case is fixed up today and record and G.R. case and C.D. of the concerned case are also available with the court.

Heard. Considered the submissions placed. Considered.

Prayer is allowed.

Date of hearing of this Misc.- case is shifted back to today from 13.07.2026 and the same be treated as one in today's cause list.

Put up little later for hearing.

Later: Order No. 03 dated 09.07.2026:

The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sk. Matiyar Rahaman @ Tutul in connection with Madhabdihi P.S. Case No. 133 of 2026 dated 06.06.2026 U/Ss 329(4)/115(2)/308(2)/109(1)/74/304(2)/324(4)/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. is now taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case out of political grudge. He is in custody since 15.06.2026. Some other accused persons have already been granted bail by this court. I.O. made no prayer for taking this accused in P.C. There is no recovery of any incriminating articles from him. Amount of money allegedly involved in the offence is very small. Further detention will serve no fruitful purpose. It is further submitted that no such application of these petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the petitioner with his associates being armed with deadly weapons trespassed into the house of the complainant and demanded a sum of Rs. 70000/-. When the complainant refused, they assaulted him physically and outraged the modesty of his wife and stole away Rs. 9200/-.

It appears that the petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of time. There is no recovery. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances, and period of detention undergone, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

The accused petitioner named above thus may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 5,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
