The application for bail U/S 483 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Narayan Deyashi in connection with Ausgram P.S. Case No. 267 of 2026 dated 12.06.2026 U/Ss 448/427/379/506/34 is taken up for hearing.

Record of relevant G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner is in custody since 29.06.2026. Alleged incident took place long time ago in the year 2021. Petitioner was not taken on P.C. after his arrest. He has been falsely implicated in this case out of political grudge. It is further submitted that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court on any previous occasion. Hence, he prays for grant of bail on any condition, as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection and submits that there are sufficient incriminating materials in the C.D. against the petitioner.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that on 03.05.2021 present petitioner with his associates being armed with iron rod, bamboo stick, explosive and fire arms attacked and vandalized the house of the complainant. They hurled bombs and looted away gold ornaments, cash and other valuables. Subsequently they fined the complainant with a sum of Rs. 70,000/- which the complainant refused to pay for which he was ostracized.

On perusal of the materials available in the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has examined several witnesses and recorded their statements which corroborates the allegations made in the F.I.R. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offence alleged, supporting materials in the C.D., and initial stage of investigation, prayer of the petitioner U/S 483 B.N.S.S. is rejected.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of relevant G.R. case be sent down to the Ld. C.J.M. Burdwan for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

This criminal misc.- case is thus disposed of.
