: The Defacto Complainant/Kondru Sudha and Accused no.1 present. The complainant reported that she is willing to compromise the matter in this case and as such an application was filed by her U/Sec. 20 of LSA and refer the matter to Lok Adalath Bench. Members of Bench present. Defacto-complainant appear before this court and accused no.1 is present and identified by concerned Police. The alleged offences U/Sec.498-A & 506 of IPC is compoundable in nature. Observation period of (90) days is waived off. Hence, compromise is recorded for the offences U/Sec. 498-A & 506 of IPC. In terms of compromise, accused no.1 to 3 are acquitted U/Sec.320(8) Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable U/Sec. 498-A & 506 of IPC. The bail bonds of accused no.1 to 3 shall stand cancelled. Further, the learned APP filed a petition U/Sec.321 Cr.P.C. as the parties settled the case U/Sec.498-A & 506 of IPC out of the court. Hence, no purpose would be served to prosecution U/Sec.3 and 4 of DP Act and requested this Honourable Court to withdraw from the prosecution U/Sec. 3 and 4 of DP Act against accused. Considering the request of the learned APP, they permitted to withdraw from the prosecution U/Sec. 3 and 4 of DP Act against accused no.1 to 3 vide Crl.MP.No. 565 of 2024. Accordingly accused no. 1 to 3 are acquitted U/Sec.321 Cr.P.C. for the above said offence.
