Today is fixed for further order awaiting receipt of the record of G.R. Case from the learned C.J.M., Burdwan, after exhausting process.

In spite of repeated reminders, neither the record of G.R. Case after completing process is returned, nor even any report regarding the present status of the case is received from the Court of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purba Bardhaman.

Though all steps were ordered to be taken before the Court of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purba Bardhaman and accused persons were directed to attend that Court till receipt of the record by this Court, again a petition showing absence of the accused persons has been put in today. Let it be kept with the record.

It reveals that since the G.R. Case was committed without completion of the process against some of the accused persons, the record of G.R. Case was returned to the Court of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Burdwan for completion of all necessary processes and for resubmitting the same record to this Court.

In the circumstances, notice of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Burdwan is attracted with a request either to transmit records of G.R. Case No.3605 of 2016, if all process has been exhausted meanwhile, or a report regarding the present status of the case, by the next date fixed.
