Order no. 02 dated 29.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Prosenjit Ghosh, (2) Rajesh Ghosh, (3) Gadadhar Ghosh, (4) Madhab Ghosh, and (5) Gopi Mohon Ghosh who apprehend arrest in connection with Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 285 of 2026 dated 04.07.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/117(2)/118(2)/324(4)/74/352/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

By showing some documents, it is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that the petitioner no.3 was severely assaulted by the complainant party for which he lodged one F.I.R. which was registered as Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 286 of 2026 dated 04.07.2026. They are the victims and have been falsely implicated. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection against the prayer of the petitioners.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the petitioners picked up quarrel with the complainant and when he protested, they gave blows on his left hand and head with Heso causing bleeding injuries. When his daughter rushed to save him, they also assaulted her physically and outraged her modesty. They gave blows on the left hand of his daughter with Heso.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has recorded the statements of witnesses and also collected the medical documents showing bone deep head injury. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offence and injury and supporting materials in the C.D., their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is rejected.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
