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Order no. 03 dated 10.08.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Nasir Sk. who apprehends arrest in connection with Ausgram P.S. Case No. 171 of 2026 dated 05.05.2026 U/Ss 85/115(2)/316(2)/82(1)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been falsely implicated. There is no specific allegation against the present petitioner. Moreover, some other accused persons have been granted bail by the court. By showing some document it is further submitted that previously also the complainant has filed one case u/s 85 of B.N.S. against the accused persons. Petitioner is a local resident having no chance of his abscondence. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that since after marriage the husband and in law subjected the complainant to physical and mental torture on demand of further dowry. The petitioner husband maintains illicit relationship with a woman and he also contracted second marriage.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has recorded the statements of witnesses and also collected a copy of the marriage certificate. Considering the materials available, facts and circumstances and nature of allegation, his prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner in connection with the above noted case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till conclusion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
