Order no. 02 dated 22.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Binod Prasad Bhagat, (2) Raj Lakhi Bhagar, (3) Santosh Kumar Bhakat, (4) Bishakha Bhakat, and (5) Arun Thakur who apprehend arrest in connection with Burdwan (Women) P.S. Case No. 111 of 2026 dated 06.06.2026 U/Ss 85/316(2)/319(2)/115(2)/118(1)/109(1)/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that the complainant has falsely implicated her husband, in laws and even neighbours. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises mild objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that after marriage she detected that her husband is impotent. When she advised him for medical treatment, the husband and in laws tortured her. They also tortured her on demand of further dowry. Lastly they took away her stridhan property and drove her out from the matrimonial home.

It appears from the C.D. that the I.O. has examined several witnesses and recorded their statements. No medical document has been collected. Considering the materials available, nature of allegation and injury and facts and circumstances of the case, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
