Order no. 02 dated 29.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Ranjit Gurung who apprehend arrest in connection with Burdwan P.S. Case No. 848 of 2026 dated 21.06.2026 U/Ss 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/308(2)/324(4)/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

By showing some documents, it is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that previously the complainant also filed a complaint with the same allegation in which he is on bail. This petitioner has been falsely implicated out of grudge. Moreover, he has complied with the notice issued u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises mild objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It alleged that on 27.04.2026 the petitioner with his associates came to the complainant's house and abused in filthy language. As the complainant protested they assaulted her physically and vandalized her house. The complainant made a complaint with Burdwan P.S. Subsequently the accused persons exerted the pressure on her for withdrawing the case and extorted a sum of Rs. 1 lakh.

On perusal of the materials in the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has recorded the statements of the witnesses. It does not appear that complainant had no access to law enforcing agency. Already one F.I.R. was lodged. The petitioner has also complied with the notice issued u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S. Considering the materials in the C.D., and facts and circumstances, prayer of the petitioner U/S 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner in connection with the above noted case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction that he shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till conclusion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
