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Order no. 02 dated 29.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Tapan Kumar Das, and (2) Paban Kumar Das who apprehend arrest in connection with Memari P.S. Case No. 430 of 2026 dated 03.06.2026 U/Ss 223/329(4)/115(2)/303(2)/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that these petitioners did not commit any serious offence and have been falsely implicated in this case out of property dispute. Civil suit is also pending between the parties. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge informs that investigation has been completed.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that on completion of investigation, the I.O. has submitted charge sheet for the offences alleged. Considering the materials available and fact that charge sheet has been submitted, custodial interrogation of the petitioners does not appear to be necessary. Accordingly, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

Above named accused petitioners are directed to surrender before the concerned court within 7 working days hereof and in case they surrender, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
