Order no. 04 dated 20.08.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Samsur Alam @ Mana, who apprehends arrest in connection with Katwa P.S. Case No. 417 of 2026 dated 09.06.2026 U/Ss 329(3)/324(4)/308(2)(3)/351(2)/61(2) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that from the very inception there is irregularity in the case. Case was registered for bailable offence but on the erroneous conception co- accused being arrested was remanded to P.C. Subsequently non bailable section was added. Ld. Advocate further submits that this petitioner is a contractor. He simply carried out the government order and raised building. Some documents in support of his contention has been filed. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection and submits that matter reached to the Hon'ble High Court and there are adequate incriminating materials in the C.D.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the petitioner with other accused persons named in the F.I.R. extorted different sums of money from the complainant on different pretext. They demolished the boundary wall of his property.

The petitioner has submitted the copy of work order issued by the Executive Engineer, Burdwan Division, M.E. Directorate and related documents. Considering the materials available, documents shown and facts and circumstances, and role of the petitioner in the alleged offence, his prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner in connection with the above noted case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction to meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till conclusion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
