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Order no. 02 dated 29.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sher Ali Sk. @ Saher Ali Seikh who apprehend arrest in connection with Katwa G.R.P.S. Case No. 06 of 2026 dated 16.05.2026 U/Ss 195(1)/221/121(1)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner did not commit any serious offence as alleged and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Moreover, some other accused persons standing on the same footings have been granted anticipatory bail by this court. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises mild objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It alleged that the petitioner with his associates led a mob of 400 to 500 persons and obstructed the Railway officials from discharging their duties. Officials and R.P.F. personnel tried to pacify the mob but they turned violent and pelted stones on them and six R.P.F. personnel sustained injuries.

On perusal of the materials in the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has collected some medical documents. Considering the materials in the C.D., nature of allegation and injury and facts and circumstances, prayer of the petitioner U/S 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner in connection with the above noted case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction that the petitioner shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
