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Order no. 02 dated 27.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sk. Ayub @ Sk. Md. Ayub who apprehend arrest in connection with Bhatar P.S. Case No. 303 of 2026 dated 04.06.2026 U/Ss 318(4)/308(5)/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that this petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He is not involved in the offence in any way. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection.

Ld. Advocate for the de facto complainant appeared before this court by filing a vokalatnama along with the de facto complainant and the complainant by filing an affidavit submits that he has no objection if prayer of this petitioner is allowed.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It alleged that the petitioner and co- accused persons illegally demanded money from the complainant and considering his safety and security he was compelled to pay Rs. 12 lacs. to them.

Considering the materials in the C.D., nature of allegation and facts and circumstances stated above, prayer of the petitioner U/S 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioner in connection with the above noted case, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
