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Order no. 02 dated 29.07.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Khokan Dhali, (2) Pradip Bag, and (3) Pradhan Chandra Paul who apprehend arrest in connection with Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 240 of 2026 dated 13.06.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/115(2)/303(2)/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that these petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. They are local residents having no chance of their abscondance. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises mild objection.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that the petitioners physically assaulted the complainant and snatched away his cell phone..

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has examined witnesses and recorded their statements. The I.O. has also collected the medical documents. Considering the nature of allegation and injury, facts and circumstances of the case and materials in the C.D., prayer of the rest petitioners u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further direction that these petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
